Family Movie and Craft Night — Tuesday, March 26, 4:30-6:30 p.m., all ages, Community Event Room.

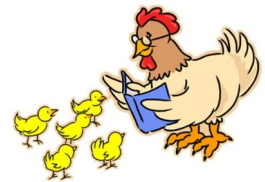
Families are invited to a Family Movie and Craft Night.

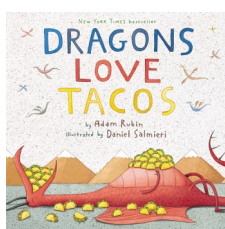


Pokémon Club — Saturday, March 2, 11 a.m. - 12 p.m., ages 7-16, Children's Event Room.
