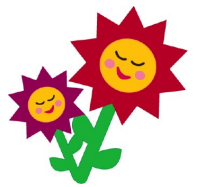




# Vineland Public Library Children's Department

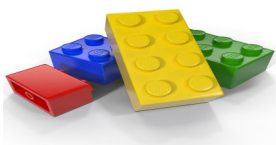
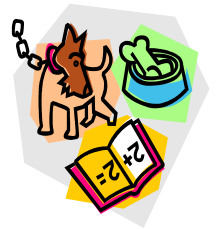


## Ages 5 & up
