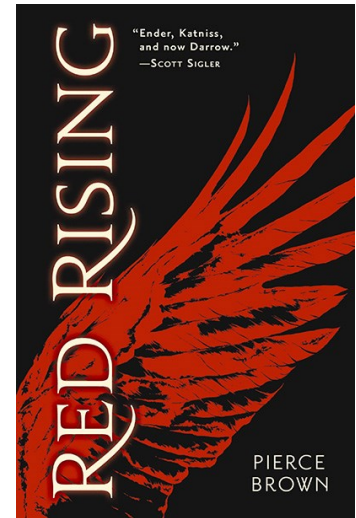

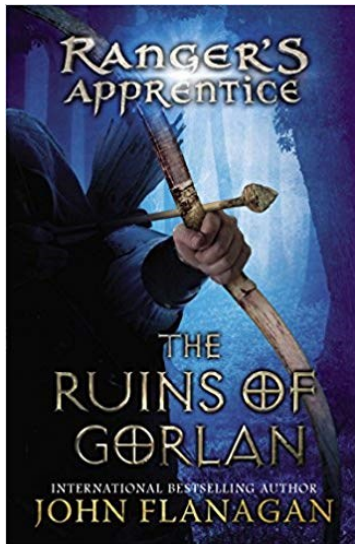
Ages 13 to 18
