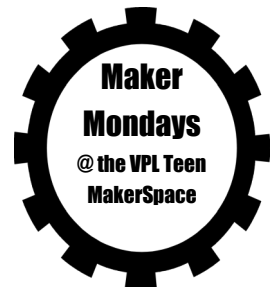
#### Teen Maker Mondays & Teen Room Hours

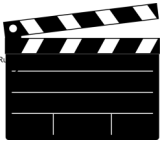
