

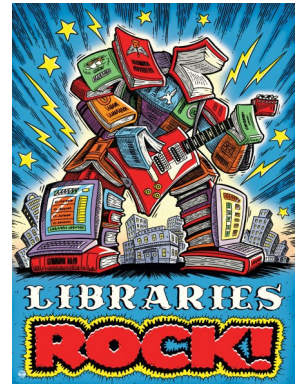


Vineland Public Library 2018 Summer Programs for Teens Ages 13-18

Log Your Reading Time This Summer and Win Prizes!

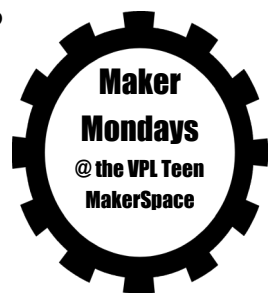
