The exhibit includes original watercolor paintings and most of the art is available for purchase. The public is invited to a “Meet the Artist” reception on **Saturday, August 23 from 1:00 – 3:00 p.m.** in the Doris Tripp Room.

John Hood, a Navy Veteran and retired Director of Information Technology, realized that retirement was meant to enjoy and began to pursue his artistic abilities. Throughout his life, John enjoyed sketching and drawing as a pastime which led him to take a college course in watercolors. He continues taking classes, exhibiting and participating in local galleries and art shows. Recently he received a second place award in Camden County’s senior citizen juried art show. Accord-



ing to the artist, “Watercolor is a very powerful way to express my feelings. I truly love watercolor with its unpredictability continuing to excite me when it is set free and does what it wants.”

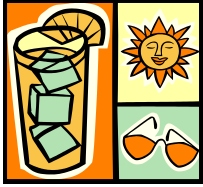
