## Celebrate Take Your Child to the Library Day!

Parents are always encouraged to bring their children to the library, but the Vineland Public Library is asking parents to make a special effort to visit the library on the first Saturday in February in honor of Take Your Child to the Library Day.

Children ages 12 & younger who visit the Vineland Public Library Children's Department on **February 7th** any time between **10 a.m. and 4 p.m.** will receive a free book, while supplies last. Parents/legal guardians are encouraged to get their child a library card. Adults must present a photo ID and proof of residency in the cities of Vineland, Millville or Bridgeton to apply for a free library card. Library card applications will be accepted until 4:30 p.m. that day.

**Children ages 8 and younger must be accompanied by an adult at all times in the library.**

The gift books are funded by The Friends of the Vineland Public Library.

Take Your Child to the Library Day is a Connecticut-grown, grass-roots project dreamed up in 2012 by Nadine Lipman, the retired Head of Children's Services at the Waterford, CT Public Library. Now libraries across the country have joined the celebration.

In 2014 at the Vineland Public Library:

- **40,264** reference questions were answered.
- **173,746** items circulated.
- The computers were used **33,156** times.
- **2,648** patrons registered for a new library card.
- **88** volunteers donated **2,061.75** hours of their time.
