## Free Scanning Now Available at the Vineland Public Library



The Vineland Public Library now has a scanner available for public use at the Information Desk on the first floor. The scanner may be used to create digital copies of documents and photographs, so that they can be emailed or stored electronically.

The scanning process at the library is simple and free of charge. Information Desk staff will demonstrate how to use the scanner and answer your questions. If you do not have an email account but would like a digital copy of the scanned material, bring a flash drive so you can save your scans.

The new scanner and its accompanying computer were purchased with funds from the Friends of the Vineland Public Library. Use of the scanner does not require a library card; however, individuals who live in Vineland and would like to take advantage of the other services offered by the library, such as borrowing books and DVDs or using Ancestry.com, can apply for a free Vineland Library card at the front desk. Proof of address and ID are required to get a free library card.
