New Jersey is celebrating its 350th Anniversary this month! In honor of this historic milestone, the Vineland Public Library is hosting a number of events all about the nation's 3rd state. Programs include interactive storytelling, a butterfly slide show, a history lesson about the Jersey shore, and more. "The Brilliant Life of a Butterfly"

In celebration of New Jersey's 350th Anniversary, local nature photographer Phillip M. Ballou will host a slide show on a butterfly's life at the Vineland Public Library on **Monday, June 9 from 6:00-7:30 p.m.** This slide show will take place in the Community Event Room. Pictorial slides include butterflies from egg to chrysalis, nectar plants that host butterflies, and Monarch butterflies wintering in Mexico. 
"Floating Cabins of the Delaware"


PROGRAM CANCELLED
