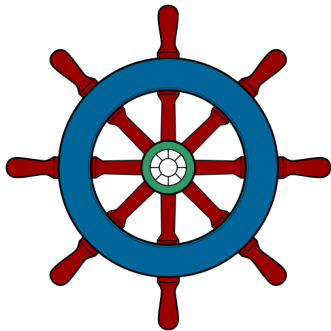

Free Job Search Computers @ VPL

Are you looking for work? Do you need the Internet to apply for jobs? Are you struggling with formatting your résumé? The library can help! Ask about our free job search computers! There are five computers designated for individuals searching and applying for jobs. The job search computers are free to use and have access to the Internet and Career Transitions – a free database allowing users to create a résumé and cover letter, learn interview techniques, and search for jobs. Free résumé templates are also available. All library computers are operational during the following hours: Monday – Thursday (9:00 a.m. – 7:45 p.m.); Friday and Saturday (9:00 a.m. – 4:45 p.m.).

For general computer access, residents of Vineland, Millville, and Bridgeton can get a free library card by showing photo ID and proof of residence and filling out a short form at the library’s Front Desk.
