Beatrice's Book Review



Hello readers,

Thanksgiving is almost here! I am sure many people are busy preparing for the holiday, so I thought it would be nice to share a recipe this month. The tasty treat in this article is from *Williams-Sonoma Thanksgiving Entertaining* (641.568 PAP):

Fresh Cranberry Relish (Serves 10-12)

Ingredients:

- 1 large orange
- 1 large tart apple
- 3 cups fresh cranberries
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 2 thin slices peeled fresh ginger

Directions:

- Quarter the unpeeled orange and remove any seeds.
- Cut the orange into 1-in. pieces.
- Quarter and core the unpeeled apple and cut into 1 -in. chunks.
- In a food processor, combine the orange, apple, cranberries, sugar and ginger. Process until finely minced.
- Transfer to an airtight container, cover, and store in the refrigerator for up to 2 weeks.
