

Library Reopening Guidelines

Here are some things you should know before coming to the library.

- Only 25 patrons will be permitted in the building at one time. Enter at the side door only.
- There will be a limit of only 15 minutes per day to browse and check out .
- You must make an appointment to use our computers and there is a 30 minute limit per day.
- Face masks covering the nose and mouth must be worn at all times. There will be no exceptions. You must adhere to social distance guidelines.
- Upon entering the building, patrons will be required to hand sanitize and provide their name and phone number or email for contact tracing.
- To protect the public health, there will be no food or drinks allowed and seating has been temporarily removed.
- The vending machine area, teen room, public meeting rooms, rest rooms, book sale room and quiet study room will remain closed.
- The Children's Department is closed, except for in-person library material requests.
- Reference books, newspapers and magazines will not be available for browsing. Magazines may be checked out and taken home.
- Copying, scanning and printing will be available, but the fax machine will not.
- All library items must be returned in the drop box at the front of the building. They will be quarantined for 72 hours.
- Curbside service is available Monday ,Wednesday, and Friday 9:00 am - 5:00 pm and Tuesday and Thursdays 9:00 am - 6:00 pm.
- The library is not accepting book donations at this time.
