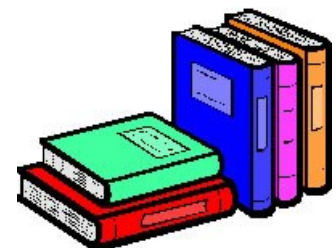

## Free ESL Classes at VPL!

The Vineland Pubic Library is offering free Survival English (ESL) classes beginning in September.

New Survival ESL (English as a Second Language) classes will be held in September. The classes target individuals whose low English level prevents them from interacting with English speakers in their daily lives. The classes will focus on vocabulary for daily life and the basic grammar patterns of English.

Classes for beginning students will start on **Monday, September 14**. Beginning classes will take place every Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 3:00 - 4:00 p.m. Classes for intermediate students will begin on **Tuesday, September 15**. Intermediate classes will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10:30 – noon.

All classes are free and open to residents of Vineland who are at least 18 years old and grew up speaking any language other than English. Classes will meet in the library's Community Event Room, which is located on the first floor of the library. **Interested students can register on the first day of class. They must bring their library card with them to register and a notebook and pencil to use in class.**

Residents of Vineland can get a free library card by showing photo ID, proof of residence, and completing a short form at the Circulation Desk. For more information, please contact the Adult Services Department at 856-794-4244 ext. 4243.
