We are excited to announce hoopla digital: a new digital media service provided to you, our patron, through which you may access and enjoy nearly half a million titles, from six different formats: **Movies, TV, Music Albums, eAudiobooks, eBooks, and Comics/Graphic Novels.** All in one location, from your computer, tablet or Smartphone!



With hoopla, there are no hold lists, no extra apps or accounts needed or special steps to use it, and no fines.

On a mobile device, borrowed content may be temporarily downloaded and accessed offline, or in either the app or on a computer. All borrowed content may be enjoyed while connected to the internet by streaming.

We really love this service. It is easy to use and provides our library patrons instant access (again, with no waiting!!) to any titles they want. As a library cardholder, **you may borrow up to 4 titles per month.**

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

Hi Readers,

I have decided to take the 2018 Vineland Library Reading Challenge! It's truly going to be a challenge for me since I will have to step out of my comfort zone quite a bit. Participants must read a book from each of the 12 categories to be entered into a drawing for a \$25.00 gift card. I technically work at the library, so I won't be eligible for the prize - but figured I will still enjoy the game. Since I didn't know which books to pick, I put myself in the capable hands of our librarians to make the decision. After seeing what they have in store for me, I am quite worried! Most of the categories are within my interest, but the "non-fiction science" selection may be a problem. The librarians selected *Astrophysics for People in a Hurry* by Neil deGrasse Tyson (523.01 TYS). I'm leaving that one for last!

Aside from *Astrophysics for People in a Hurry*, *Harriet the Spy* by Louise Fitzhugh (J FIC FITZHUGH) made its way on to my reading list for the "published the decade you were born" category. It's a juvenile fiction book written in the 1960's. The story is about a girl who wants to be a spy. The only problem is that she writes down all her honest opinions of the people she observes. When Harriet's notebook falls into the hands of her fellow classmates, they read all of her private thoughts about them. Some of her notebook entries are nice, but some are mean. Of course the students only focus on the mean things she wrote about them. As I'm writing this I have a few chapters left to read, but I hope Harriet begins to understand that some people have reasons for being as they are or appear to be. This book teaches readers that circumstances are not always what they seem, and the old adage "don't judge a book by its cover", applies to more than just books.
