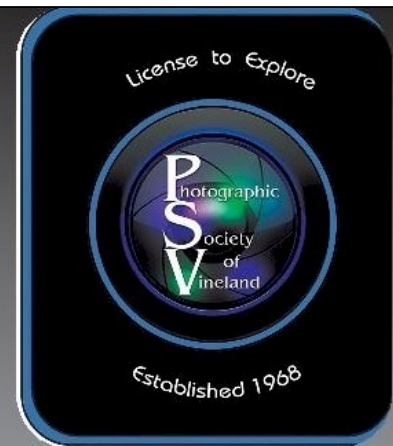




Photographic Society of Vineland Celebrating 50 Years

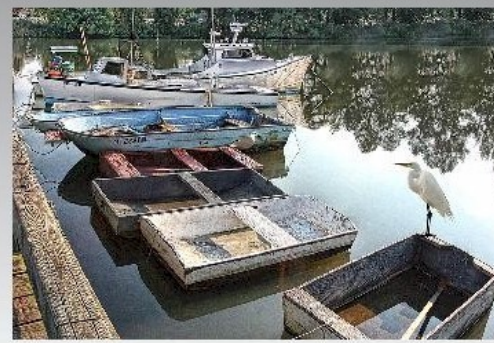
